Warfield's Annual Gardening Competition 2019

This year's Annual Gardening Competition has now been launched with a new category and we're looking for entrants in 2 categories;

1) The Best Environmental & Sustainable Front Garden Competition

2) Tallest sunflower (child); tallest sunflower (adult).

The competition is free to enter and open to all Warfield residents and organisations. You can enter yourself or nominate a neighbour. Closing date for entrants/nominations is Monday 9 July, with judging of front gardens to take place mid to late July.

Sunflowers have until approximately 14th September to reach their full height and any over 2 metres will then be judged. We still have free sunflower seeds in the office for you to collect if you'd like to take part.

Prizes will be awarded to the winner in each category and will be presented later in the year.

To obtain an application/nomination form, which also outlines judging criteria you can either contact the Parish Office or download one from our website. Our Councillors will also be out and about, looking for front gardens to nominate in their wards.
